<p>Course Objectives</p> <p>This course generally aims to familiarize second-year students with the topics regulated by the amended Personal Status Law and its supporting legislation. It is divided into two sections. The first section includes a detailed explanation of the provisions related to marriage, from beginning to end, and the resulting effects. The second section explains the provisions related to wills and inheritance, in addition to strengthening the theoretical material with judicial applications related to the practical aspect in the courts.
