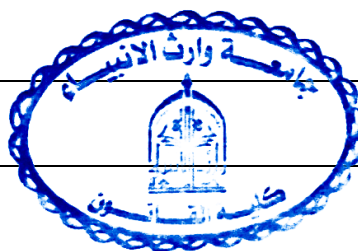

Giving lectures regularly, reviewing previous lectures , and asking questions in each lecture

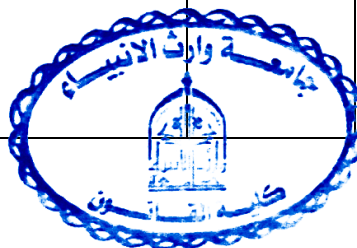
